COVID-19 Reminder

Children no longer have to isolate if they are a COVID close contact.

Children should not attend school if they develop COVID-19 symptoms at home.

If children develop symptoms at school, we ask that they take a PCR test and remain at home until the results return.

School continues to be vigilant with hygiene procedures throughout the school day. Regular handwashing and the use of sanitiser is part of our daily school routine. Classrooms are well ventilated. (Children may need an extra layer of clothing.)

We are continuing with staggered play and lunchtimes and key stage assemblies.

Thank you for maintaining social distancing on the playground when you collect your child/ren and for moving off the playground as soon as possible on an evening.
