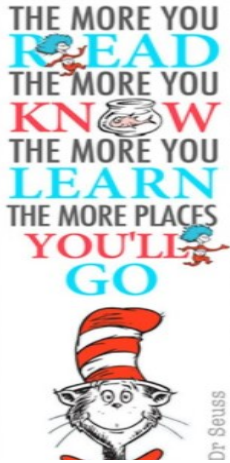
Our first meeting will be 5.15pm, Monday 7th November, here at Bewley in the school hall.
