Thank you to everyone who took part in the 1590 Trust questionnaire and also our school questionnaire. We had 245 responses from The Trust Questionnaire and are delighted to report that overall results from both surveys were very strong.

The findings from The Trust Survey can be seen in the table below.

You said:

"There are too many ways we communicate with parents"

School says:

"Teachers communicate via Marvellous Me, Tapestry (EY) and sometimes See Saw. The school office communicates via text and email. We will look at streamlining this communication.

There have been some issues when transferring to Arbor with emails, however this has been dealt with."

- You said: Wrap-around care would be good.
- £2 per day is expensive for breakfast club.

School says:

"Club are offered every night after school, however we will look at the range of clubs we currently offer as they are all sports focused.

We do signpost parents and carers to the various child-care providers we have picking up children from Bewley.

Breakfast club is the cheapest in Billingham and opens at 7.45am."
