**Literacy** 

We have been revising hard for the SPAG test and practising for our reading SAT. After SATs, we will be writing sets of instructions and creating a web page for our dream holiday. We will also be writing black-out poetry linked to our WW2 topic – A child's war. As readers, our focus texts will be 'The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas, during the first half term. In addition, pupils will focus on their retrieval skills in order to retrieve key information from a text. They will also build on their ability to find clues in a text to make inferences about events and characters' thoughts and feelings. There will be a continued focus on word meaning within context, and applying taught skills to find the meanings of unknown words. Children will also be recapping and developing understanding of word classes and applying these in context.

## History

Our topic this term will be: A Child's War: A siren sounds, a building crumbles, a Spitfire zooms overhead. Take Cover! It's 1939 and Britain is at war. Deep down in the Anderson Shelter, learn why nations are fighting and why child evacuees must make the long journey from their homes and families into unknown territory.

## <u>Art</u>

We will be completing an art project based on the work of Franz Marc in the fauvist style.

## Music and Drama

We will be learning lots of new songs and rehearsing for our end-of-year production.

## <u>PSHE</u>

We will be learning about managing budgets in our enterprise unit.

## **Transition**

Throughout the term, there will be many transition activities to help the children prepare for life at their new secondary school.

## **Robinwood**

A class residential to Robinwood is booked in for 26<sup>th</sup> of June for those children who have signed up and paid their deposits.

#### DT

In DT this term, we will be making usable bags.

## <u>PE</u>

The children will be encourage to use their skills to create a game which has working variables to track scores and time the game.
