Key Skills

- Ask and answer simple questions on a few familiar topics
- Speak in longer sentences
- Read short passages and answer questions
- Write more extended sentences

Year 5

Topic

- Animals and pets
- Numbers 11-30
- Describing someone
- Family members
- Household items
- Food and drink – give opinions
- Months of the year

Key Skills

- Understand and respond to a range of familiar words and short phrases
- Ask and answer questions with appropriate intonation
- Say a simple rhyme from memory
- Recognise simple written phrases and begin to write them from memory

Year 4

Topic

- Learn basic greetings
- Numbers 1-10
- Classroom objects and instructions
- Colours
- Parts of the body
- Days of the week

Key Skills

- Say and repeat single words and short phrases
- Show understanding with an action
- Recognise a question and respond with a rehearsed response
- Begin to recognise written phrases
- Attempt to write simple phrases from memory
