# English

A lot of our written work this term will be linked to our topic including descriptive report writing, historical recounts and mnemonics. We will also be looking at 'Moon myths' from other cultures as well as creating some poetry. The Jamie Drake Equation is our new Vipers book to link with our topic. Children are still encouraged to read (at least four times a week) at home and spellings are given on Spelling Shed every week in preparation for a test on Friday. Your on-going support with this is much appreciated.
