

Uniform

Dear parents/carers, please can we remind you that children are encouraged to wear:

- Red jumper/sweatshirt/cardigan
- White polo shirt or plain white shirt.
- Black shoes or trainers.

Dress for P.E.

On the day that your child has PE, we ask that they come into school wearing their PE kit. This consists of plimsolls, black or red shorts and a white T- shirt. Please contact Mrs Hepple if you need support with uniform.

Jewellery

For health and safety reasons children are not allowed to wear any form of jewellery to school. Also the wearing of makeup, including nail varnish, is not permitted.

Extreme Hairstyles

The school does not permit children to have extreme haircuts that could serve as a distraction to other children and are not in keeping with the ethos of the school. This includes patterns shaved into the hair, excessive use of hair products and false hair. The definition of an extreme hairstyle is at the discretion of the headteacher. Any hair long enough to be tied back should be.

Attendance

Holidays in term time – Reminder

Please do not take holidays in term time. From 19th August 2024 a new national framework was introduced.

- The penalty notice charge has increased to £160
- A 3-year rolling timescale from the issue of the first penalty notice for unauthorised absence from school is in place.
- If a parent/carer takes a child out of school during term time a penalty notice fine may be issued.

First Offence	The penalty notice is £160 per parent/carer for each child, to be paid within 28 days. Reduced to £80 if paid within 21
Second Offence (within 3 years)	The penalty notice is £160 per parent/carer for each child, payable within 28 days. NO reduction applies.
Third Offence & Further Offences	NO FURTHER PENALTY NOTICES WILL BE ISSUED IN THE 3 YEAR ROLLING PERIOD. THE CASE COULD BE PRESENTED STRAIGHT TO THE MAGISTRATES COURT.
