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Arrangements for September 2025

Our School day begins at 8.55am for Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2. Once the classroom doors are closed the children will need to go to the front entrance and report to the office to have their arrival registered. To be sure that your child isn't late for class it would be helpful if you could ensure they enter the playground gates by 8.50am. Any child arriving after 8.55am will be marked in the register as 'late'.

Younger siblings can enter with older siblings apart from Nursery and Reception children. Children come into class via their designated entrance and into their classroom door between 8.45am and 8.55am. Children who arrive late, after 8.55am should come into school via the main entrance.

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Attendance

Holidays in term time – Reminder

Please do not take holidays in term time. From 19th August 2024 a new national framework was introduced.

- The penalty notice charge has increased to £160
- A 3-year rolling timescale from the issue of the first penalty notice for unauthorised absence from school is in place.
- If a parent/carer takes a child out of school during term time a penalty notice fine may be issued.

First Offence	The penalty notice is £160 per parent/carer for each child, to be paid within 28 days. Reduced to £80 if paid within 21
Second Offence (within 3 years)	The penalty notice is £160 per parent/carer for each child, payable within 28 days. NO reduction applies.
Third Offence & Further Offences	NO FURTHER PENALTY NOTICES WILL BE ISSUED IN THE 3 YEAR ROLLING PERIOD. THE CASE COULD BE PRESENTED STRAIGHT TO THE MAGISTRATES COURT.
