

Please keep these safe at home!


### Internet Safety

## Attendance

### Holidays in term time – Reminder

Please do not take holidays in term time. From 19<sup>th</sup> August 2024 a new national framework was introduced.

- **The penalty notice charge has increased to £160**
- **A 3-year rolling timescale from the issue of the first penalty notice for unauthorised absence from school is in place.**
- **If a parent/carer takes a child out of school during term time a penalty notice fine may be issued.**

<b>First Offence</b>	The penalty notice is <b>£160 per parent/carer for each child, to be paid within 28 days. Reduced to £80 if paid within 21.</b>
<b>Second Offence (within 3 years)</b>	The penalty notice is <b>£160 per parent/carer for each child, payable within 28 days. NO reduction applies.</b>
<b>Third Offence &amp; Further Offences</b>	<b>NO FURTHER PENALTY NOTICES WILL BE ISSUED IN THE 3 YEAR ROLLING PERIOD.</b> <b>THE CASE COULD BE PRESENTED STRAIGHT TO THE MAGISTRATES COURT.</b>

### Good Attendance and Punctuality = Good Learning

The importance of being punctual and coming to school can never be underestimated, in terms of contributing massively to children’s learning. We cannot stress how important it is that children are in school.

### Should I keep my child off school?

**Yes**

	Until...
Chickens	at least 5 days from the onset of the virus and until all children have cleared cases
Diphtheria and Whooping Cough	48 hours after the last episode
Cold and Flu like illness (including COVID-19)	if they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the national guidance 7 days unless guided for COVID-19
Impetigo	if all sores have cleared and treated, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics
Measles	4 days after the rash first appeared
Mumps	5 days after the swelling started
Scarlet Fever	if you've had their first treatment
Scarlet Fever	24 hours after they started taking antibiotics
Whooping Cough	48 hours after they started taking antibiotics

# Should I keep my child off school?

## Yes

### Until...

<b>Chickenpox</b>	at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over
<b>Diarrhoea and Vomiting</b>	48 hours after their last episode
<b>Cold and Flu-like illness (including COVID-19)</b>	they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the national guidance if they've tested positive for COVID-19.
<b>Impetigo</b>	their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics
<b>Measles</b>	4 days after the rash first appeared
<b>Mumps</b>	5 days after the swelling started
<b>Scabies</b>	they've had their first treatment
<b>Scarlet Fever</b>	24 hours after they started taking antibiotics
<b>Whooping Cough</b>	48 hours after they started taking antibiotics
