English

A lot of our written work this term will be linked to our topics (Ancient Egyptians and WW1) including historical recounts and reports, as well as descriptive writing including diary entries. We will also be looking at poetry from the First World War.



Children are encouraged to read at least 4 times a week at home. Spellings are given every week on Spelling Shed in preparation for an online test on Friday. Your on-going support with this is much appreciated.

Geography

We will be learning about maps and alliances from WW1 and prior. Discussing empires of the world at the time and who controlled what. Using keys to highlight key information.

History

We will be learning about Ancient Egyptians, including a study of Tutankhamun.

We will also be learning about WW1 including a study about the Bombardment of Hartlepool.

Numeracy

This term we will be consolidating place value - working with numbers to 1,000,000, developing mental and written strategies for all four number operations, understanding equivalent fractions and learning to add and subtract fractions. Please continue to help your child learn their multiplication tables by heart. Children will be tested weekly on their times tables remember they can use Times Tables Rock Stars to help.



Computing

We will be completing units on online safety, systems and searching and video production, which the children always love.

Science

This term we are finding out about properties and changes of materials (including solutions, dissolving and separating) doing many exciting experiments.

Art / DT

Linking with our topic, we shall be designing and making Egyptian Canopic jars. We will then be looking at the work of Georgia O'Keeffe, in particular poppies and using this to inspire some DT textile work creating our own poppy brooches.
