Please do not take holidays in term time. From 19<sup>th</sup> August 2024 a new national framework was introduced.

- **The penalty notice charge has increased to £160**
- **A 3-year rolling timescale from the issue of the first penalty notice for unauthorised absence from school is in place.**
- **If a parent/carer takes a child out of school during term time a penalty notice fine may be issued.**

<b>First Offence</b>	The penalty notice is £160 per parent/carer for each child, to be paid within 28 days. Reduced to £80 if paid within 21
<b>Second Offence (within 3 years)</b>	The penalty notice is £160 per parent/carer for each child, payable within 28 days. NO reduction applies.
<b>Third Offence &amp; Further Offences</b>	NO FURTHER PENALTY NOTICES WILL BE ISSUED IN THE 3 YEAR ROLLING PERIOD. THE CASE COULD BE PRESENTED STRAIGHT TO THE MAGISTRATES COURT.
