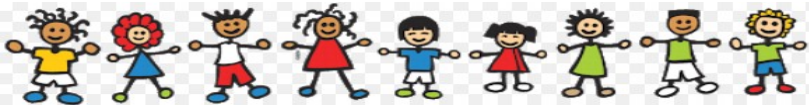

We want to share a quick update regarding school register open and closing times, arriving after the register closes and medical appointments.

Morning Arrival Times

- **8:45 AM:** School gates open.
- **8:55 AM:** Gates close and **registers open.**
- **9:25 AM:** Registers close for the morning.

Understanding Attendance Marks

We are required to record arrival times in specific ways, and we want you to be aware of how these appear on your child’s record:

- **Arrival between 8:55 and 9:25:** Your child will be marked as 'L' (Late).
- **Arrival after 9:25:** This is recorded as a 'U' (Late after registers close). Because the register is officially closed at this point, this mark does impact your child’s overall attendance percentage.

If your child has a medical appointment in the school day we encourage you to bring your child in for their mark and collect them at a suitable time to attend the appointment.
